They really need a better place to raise their children.

Juan Ramon has worked at Miramont Golf Course in Bryan for four years and Karina recently started working at Sanderson Farms. Karina’s mother is especially happy and excited for her daughter’s family to receive their own home, as she became a Habitat homeowner when Karina was 12 years old.

Together Karina and Juan Ramon have completed over 200 sweat equity hours and said they have enjoyed all of it. They’ve even made lunch for the volunteers working on another family’s home.

Juan and Karina are very appreciative of the generous sponsors who will help them build their own house. Karina knows that Habitat will make good things happen for them and is looking forward to playing with her children in their new home.

Workshop Classes: All Habitat families attend 12 homeownership classes on subjects like budgeting, fire safety, home maintenance, first aid, nutrition and more.
