She enjoys learning about the different aspects of homeownership and thinks the classes are very enjoyable. With the help of her sister, Tori has quickly completed 150 of the required 500 hours of sweat equity.

Tori has been living on her own and renting since she was 17 years old. She currently lives in a two bedroom apartment where she and her youngest son, Patrick, share a bedroom. Not surprisingly, Tori is most excited about having her own room in her new Habitat house. Gage, an 8th grader at Stephen F.
