Every year since 2007, women in the Bryan/College Station community have come together to raise funds and help build decent, affordable homes for families in need.

Women play such an important role in families, but they need a solid foundation for their families to thrive. Housing that is dilapidated, overcrowded or unaffordable threatens a family's health, well-being and future prospects. The Circle of Women members believe that when women come together to support other women, they can accomplish great things!

Participants in the Circle of Women Build give what they can of their time, talents and/or financial resources to help another family build a stable future, live healthier lives and find greater opportunities. There are several ways to participate:

- Join the Circle. Individuals, organizations and businesses each contribute \$1,000. Two individuals or a group of women may partner to give that amount. Payment is needed by October 15, 2018.\*
- Contribute a lesser amount financially. Even if you cannot join the Circle, you can be part of the group, "Women Building a Future," with a donation in any amount.
- Volunteer on the construction site. More than 200 construction volunteers will be needed on Saturdays over the course of 10 weeks. All volunteers, regardless of skill levels, are warmly welcome! Construction is slated to begin in the fall.
- Provide lunches. The construction crew and volunteers work all day. Providing lunch on site is a way to support them and say "thank you."
