Key Responsibilities:

Donation Pickup & Delivery (Driving Duties)

- Drive the ReStore box truck to pick up donated furniture, appliances, and building materials from homes and businesses.
- Assist donors with the safe and professional loading/unloading of donated items.
- Ensure all donations meet ReStore quality standards and decline items that do not align with our donation guidelines.
- Deliver purchased items to customers' homes as needed.
- Maintain the cleanliness and routine maintenance of the ReStore truck.

- Represent Habitat for Humanity in a courteous, professional manner while interacting with donors and customers.

Retail & Warehouse Operations

- Unload, sort, and process incoming donations for resale.
- Stock shelves, arrange furniture, and help create an organized and visually appealing sales floor.
- Assist customers with inquiries, loading purchases, and general store support.
- Keep the warehouse and sales floor clean, safe, and well-organized.
- Work as part of a team to ensure smooth daily store operations.
